

Research Briefings May & June 2017

Now in its twenty-third year, **The UK Graduate Careers Survey** is the largest and most authoritative annual survey of final year students at the UK's top universities. It is conducted by **High Fliers Research**, in association with *The Times* newspaper, on behalf of more than sixty major national and international graduate employers.

The survey gives these employers an *exclusive* insight into the career expectations and aspirations of final year students – just weeks before they graduate – and provides a definitive record of how they have conducted their job search whilst at university. The research results are a key source of information for employers when reviewing the success of their graduate recruitment on campus and planning future marketing campaigns.

This year's survey is based on a record **20,102 face-to-face interviews** with finalists from the 'Class of 2017' and shows there has been a dramatic change in students' graduate job applications since last summer's Brexit vote, a marked drop in confidence in the graduate employment market and a noticeable shift in students' plans for life after university.
